TROPHIES -Trophies will be presented at a later date to enable time for any engraving.

Eligibility

- The "Closed" championships as a whole may be entered by anyone who is eligible to be a full member of TFACT (that is, residents of the A.C.T. and its immediate region).
- If entrants are NOT members, but eligible to be so, they need to pay a "temporary membership" fee of \$5 to cover play on the weekend of the championships.
- Divisional events may be entered by any person who is playing in that or a lower division in the current ACT competition, or who played in that or a lower equivalent division in the last ACT competition played by him or her.
- Novice events are restricted to developing players in ACT and region schools who are not currently playing (and have not previous played) in any grade table tennis pennant competition.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Championships Director has, on behalf of Table Tennis ACT (Inc.), the sole management of the Championships. The Championships Director reserves the right, in its sole discretion to refuse entries by any player.
2. The Championships will be played under ITTF Regulations and the Current Laws of Table Tennis. ITTF gluing regulations will apply.
3. Plastic 40+ 3 star white balls will be used for all events. DHS blue tables will be used. NO WHITE CLOTHING PERMITTED. Tracksuits are not to be worn without the permission of the Referee.
4. An event will not be held unless **at least three** entries are received for the event.
5. The Championships Director reserves the right to cancel any event for any reason.
6. Where an event is cancelled or a player has entered an event they are ineligible for, any entry for that event may be transferred to another event for which the entrant is eligible. **Fees are not payable for cancelled events.**
7. Events with small numbers of entries may be played on a round-robin basis.
8. An open event may be entered by any ACT Table Tennis member.
9. A division event may be entered by any person who is playing in that or a lower division in the current ACT competition, or who played in that or a lower equivalent division in the last ACT competition played by him or her.
10. **Eligibility for Junior and Veterans events**, is as follows:
 - Under 11: Born on or after 1 January 2006
 - Under 13: Born on or after 1 January 2004
 - Under 15: Born on or after 1 January 2002
 - Under 18: Born on or after 1 January 1999
 - Over 30: Born on or before 31 December 1987
 - Over 40: Born on or before 31 December 1977
 - Over 50: Born on or before 31 December 1967
 - Over 60: Born on or before 31 December 1957
 - Over 70: Born on or before 31 December 1947
 - Over 80: Born on or before 31 December 1937
11. Matches in all events are best of five games up to 11.
12. Players will be required to umpire when requested by the Referee and/or Tournament Director.
13. The Championships Director may cancel the Championship entries of a player who does not comply with clause 16.
14. Fees for all events entered by a player are to be paid before that player may play in any event. No refunds will be allowed to players withdrawing during the tournament.
15. Players are to report to the Championships Director at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the first event in which they have entered on each day of the Championships.
16. A player who, without the permission of the Championships Director, is not ready to commence a match within 5 minutes of being called will be deemed to have forfeited that match.
17. It is the responsibility of players to personally notify Table Tennis ACT if they are unable to play an event. Messages sent via another player are not acceptable. Players must notify the championships director on 0406528486 on the day of the championships or prior to the event at ttactevents@gmail.com.
18. Players may not enter more than 5 events per day.
19. Players may enter only 2 consecutive age events in the veterans' events.
20. The "time-out" rule only applies to Events 1,2,3,4, and 5; and aged singles events.

Notes:

- (a) In age events, if there are insufficient entries for an event, players will be transferred to the next eligible event unless specifically requested otherwise (see condition 6).
- (b) Event 18 & 19 are novice events restricted to developing players in ACT schools, or players in the ACT region, who are not currently playing [and have not previously played] in any grade table tennis pennant competition. Novice school players may also enter other events if they want to.
- (c) Eligibility for events 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 (and Veterans' events) is outlined on page 2 of this Form under the heading "PROPOSED TIMETABLE & VENUE".
- (d) Players may enter only 2 consecutive age events in veterans' events (see cond. 18).
