Playing Regulations and Conventions

(For more details, refer to the *Table Tennis ACT Competition Committee Guide*)

- **Players:** All players in the competition must be registered with TTACT or an affiliated association.
- **Team captains** will be the first listed player in each team shown in the draw, unless another is elected by the team.
- **Balls:** 40+mm RADAK Plastic balls supplied by the association through the home team will be used for all divisions and the junior competition. **Clothing:** The main colour of shirt or shorts must not be white.
- **Match format:** All matches for Divisions 1 to 4 inclusive will be the best of 5 advantage games, 11 points. There will be 9 singles and 2 doubles matches per team match. For juniors there will be 4 singles and a doubles match per team.
- **Reserves:** Players must organise reserves when they can't attend. The selection of reserves must be done in accordance with the reserve table rankings detailed within each division page below. Matches will be forfeited for any breaches. For long term absences (more than two consecutive weeks) and for the finals series, reserves must be approved by the Division Manager* or the Competition Director. Players registered for a team in a division may not reserve for other teams in that division or a lower division. A player, whether regular or reserve, who has commenced a match shall not be replaced for the duration of that team match.
* The Division Manager is to take into account the spirit of selecting a reserve who is as close as possible to, but not exceeding, the playing standard of the player that they are substituting for (a player's current rating is considered). Also, reserves of a significantly lower standard of the player they are substituting for are to be avoided if feasible.
- **Start Time:** Division 1 to 4 team matches must begin by 7:00 pm unless there is agreement between captains about starting later. Junior pennant matches begin at 3:00PM. Individual matches must start within 5 minutes of the end of the previous one.
- **Time out:** During any individual match (including doubles), a player or a team member may call a 'Time Out' by signalling the umpire (after the end of a point, but before the next point starts). Only one Time Out may be called for a player during the match. The time out is to be no longer than one minute, as recorded and determined by the match umpire. If necessary, consult the Division Manager.
- **Towelling down:** Play should be continuous except if the umpire deems it necessary such as for removing moisture from the surface of a bat, which may be raised by either player before a point is played. Players are entitled to brief intervals for towelling after every 6 points from the start of each game and at the change of ends in the last possible game of an individual match.
- **Undue noise:** Players must not make undue noise that could interrupt the concentration of players on adjacent tables.
- **Competition Ladder:** Teams get 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw or bye, 1 point for a loss, 0 points for a forfeit.
- **Finals:** The top four teams will meet in semi-finals: (1) v (4), and (2) v (3); and semi-final winners will play the final in each division.

- **Player Ratings:** Results from matches (excluding forfeited matches) will be used to maintain a player points rating which will be updated weekly. An explanation of the Ratings Central Player Rating System can be found on the [TTACT website \(www.tabletennisact.org.au\)](http://www.tabletennisact.org.au).
- **Membership:** Players and reserves must be members of Table Tennis ACT. For Divisions 4 and 5 only, non-members may take out Provisional Membership that enables them to play as reserves.
- **Best player award:** To be eligible for the best player award, players must have played at least 70% of possible matches in the round robin stage before finals.
- **Forfeited matches:** Forfeited matches are taken into account in the team score; but not towards individual percentages or ratings.
- **Rules:** All players should be familiar with the rules as described in the [TTACT Competition Committee Guide](#). Please take particular note of the service rule and the use of ITTF approved racket rubbers. Remember that to promote harmony and good sportsmanship; players should not make things difficult for each other, or for umpires and vice versa. If in doubt, consult the Division Manager.
- **Member Protection Policy:** All TTACT members are bound by the [TTA Member Protection Policy](#) which outlines measures to address bullying, discrimination and harassment and to protect children from harm and abuse. It outlines how TTACT will meet its obligations, maintain responsible behaviour from all members and provide fair decision making procedures. Disciplinary action will be taken for any breaches of this policy.
- **Division Managers:** On the night of their competition, Division Managers have the authority of the Board to provide leadership in organising various aspects of the competition and to resolve issues about conduct of play on those nights. They open up the centre at the beginning of the evening and close up (or delegate close up) at the end of the evening's play. The Division Managers act as the referee for their division. (Umpires are the final arbiters of the facts of a disputed point, but the referee may overrule about interpretation of these facts).
- **The serve:** To be legal, a serve must commence from behind the base line, and from above the table surface. The ball shall be presented and held still in the palm of the hand (unless it is not possible due to disability) prior to commencement of the serve. The ball shall be tossed vertically at least 16 cm and struck while falling. The ball shall be clearly visible to the opposing player(s) and the umpire. Players who do not abide by these requirements should work on them, and consult the Division Manager as necessary.
- **Misbehaviour (and the role of Division Manager):** Incidents of misbehaviour, such as swearing or violent behaviour, should in the first instance be reported to the Division Manager. Serious incidents of misbehaviour will be referred by the Division Manager to the TTACT Board.
